- Assemble Queanbeyan park
- Ride starts in Meredith St
- Right into Stornaway St
- Left into Morton St
- Left into Naylor St
- Right into Surveyor St
- Left into Crinoline
- Right into Cascade St
- Left into Munro Rd
- Then Right thru Underpass
- Right into Gilmore St to end
- Right Bicentennial Park Path
- Cycle Path to cross Southbar Rd with care
- Left into North Terrace
- Right off roundabout to Morella Drive
- Join with Carol Jackson Drive
- Left onto Halloran Drive
- Right onto Numerelia Dr
- Thru on Stringybark Drv
- Right Brudenell St to Jerra. Community Centre

**Back:**

- Follow cycle paths to Edwin Land Cycleway
- Left into Halloran Dr
- Return via Halloran Dr, Carol Jackson & Morella Av
